## TILAPIA

### INGREDIENTS

4 Tilapia filets  
1/4 c. parmesan cheese  
2 Tbsp butter, softened  
1 1/2 tbsp mayo  
1 Tbsp fresh lemon juice  
1/2 tsp dill seasoning  
Salt + pepper to taste

#### Cilantro Lime Sauce:

1/2 c. sour cream  
1 lime, squeezed  
1/2 c. cilantro, chopped  
1/2 tsp minced garlic

### INSTRUCTIONS

Turn broiler on high and adjust rack to top  
Combine all ingredients except tilapia  
Place tilapia on a SPRAYED foil-lined pan, broil 3-4 minutes  
Remove from oven, flip over and spread parmesan mixture over fish  
Broil an additional 3-4 min  
Serve immediately with cilantro-lime sauce
